

IUP Cost Snapshot

We’ve recently made changes to keep an IUP education affordable for all students. Undergraduate students pay a flat tuition rate when taking 12-18 credits per semester.

Financial Aid: What You Need to Know

We're your partner in this process, and we're here to help. Here are the basics:

- To be considered for financial aid, you must submit the **Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)**, available at studentaid.gov.
 - The FAFSA helps determine eligibility for grants, loans, some scholarships, and work-study programs. All students are encouraged to submit the FAFSA, even if you think you won't qualify.
 - If you will be attending college from July 1, 2027, to June 30, 2028, you will complete the 2027-28 FAFSA.
 - We anticipate the FAFSA application to be available beginning **October 2026**. It is best to file the FAFSA early and before May 1 to be considered for Pennsylvania state aid.
 - This application uses your family's tax information from 2025.
 - IUP's Federal School Code is **003277**. You'll need this for the FAFSA.
- If you are a Pennsylvania resident, be sure to submit your FAFSA by **May 1, 2027** and then complete the PA State Grant application at www.pheaa.org.
- Qualified students are automatically awarded scholarships based on their application for admission. Some special programs (Promising Scholars, Crimson Scholars Circle, Cook Honors College, and Business Honors) have additional applications or processes for consideration.
- IUP will begin sending financial aid offer notifications in late November to admitted students who have a FAFSA on file with IUP.
- If your family's income has been reduced since 2025, please contact the Financial Aid Office to request a Special Circumstance Appeal form after filing the FAFSA. Completing the Special Circumstance Appeal will allow us to re-evaluate your financial aid eligibility based on your current income.
